Why is work experience important?

Young people nowadays can be some of the most disadvantaged in the labour market because they lack the experience and exposure to job-specific skills that most employers require of them. In the last few years, there has been a notable shift in attitudes towards work experience, both from the business community and at Government level.

Work experience is essential to advance in any path (Sixth From, College, Apprenticeship, T-Level, University or Employment) because it teaches you about yourself and you gain skills during the process. Usually, any work experience is better than no work experience. Good work experience prepares you for your next step in life.

Another benefit of having work experience is that you start a professional network to help advance your career in the future. With sufficient work experience, you may feel competent, knowledgeable and confident to progress quicker.




NEW ON OUR WEBSITE
