

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



WHAT IS THE COFFEE SHOP ENTERPRISE CHALLENGE?

This day is a great opportunity to help highlight various aspects of the working world. It showcases the hospitality industry along with providing students with the chance to undertake tasks to introduce them to various aspects of business: marketing, teamwork, HR, design, negotiation, finance, and more.

Students design the building for their coffee shop, looking at structures, materials, sustainability etc. We discuss what is new in the market and what customers' demands are now when dining out and socialising.

After researching, students work in teams to design their own Coffee Shop. They first make plans on a small scale, with pencil sketches. After that the fun begins with colours, paints, tissue paper, magazines, felt pens etc.

Research reveals benefits of high-quality careers education

A <u>research study</u> by the **Careers & Enterprise Company (CEC)** has found that schools meeting the 8 Gatsby Benchmarks can significantly reduce the odds of their students being NEET or in an 'unknown destination.'

The welcome analysis and report shows that highquality careers provision by schools is critical for young people to leave school 'career-ready', particularly economically disadvantaged pupils.

We welcomed our first cohort of Apprentice Ambassadors this term. These inspiring young people have agreed to support local schools, talking to students about their experiences of the world of work.






