As well as organising and participating in these, Jan also deals with T-Level placements, 1:2:1 chats with students who have any concerns with their work experience, and office administration.

WORK EXPERIENCE

Work experience placements are in full swing here at Proactive!

The latest three schools to send students out on work experience placements are:

All of these placements have taken place in the week commencing **March 18**.

What are... EXTENDED PLACEMENTS?

Extended placements are work experience placements where the student will do 1 or 2 days weekly for a part or full academic year.

They are reviewed half-termly to make sure all is well with both the placement provider and the student.

Extended placements allow the student to have a gradual introduction to work experience but gain important knowledge, training and skills across the year.

FURTHER HELP WITH WORK EXPERIENCE PLANNING: BBC BITESIZE CAREERS

The BBC has introduced a new section to its popular Bitesize website: Bitesize Careers.

BBC Bitesize Careers offers young people aged 11 to 16+ a range of content to help them make decisions about which future careers they might consider.

You'll find videos, quizzes, activities, a new podcast series, and even a 'job swap' film fronted by Dr Ranj Singh with BBC Radio 1 DJ, Charlie Tee.
