SUPPORTING STUDENTS WITH THE NEW T-LEVEL QUALIFICATIONS

T Levels are a new qualification for students aged 16 to 19 in England who have finished their GCSEs. Each T Level is equivalent to 3 A levels and helps young people develop the knowledge, attitude, and practical skills to thrive in the workplace.

T Level students spend 80% of the course in the classroom, learning the essential skills that your employees need. The other 20% is a meaningful industry placement, where they put these skills into action.

Employer responsibilities

Employers need to provide:

- a safe work environment
- opportunities for the student to develop their technical skills within your industry
- a line manager to support, supervise and mentor the student
- an induction which includes explaining relevant policies and procedures
- formal feedback on the student's progress against the agreed learning goals at the end of the placement

Benefits of T Levels: industry placements

T Levels can support employers by offering early access to a talent pipeline for entry-level positions, can help with recruitment, improve innovation and increase an organisation's productivity.

By September 2023, there will be more than 20 T Level courses, covering 11 skill areas. Within each course, students develop an understanding of a broad range of issues relevant to the sector, as well as topics specific to the course and an occupational specialism.
